

RV Trip Checklist

Use this list to prepare your RV to leave a campsite or leave on a trip:

- Lower TV Antenna
- Turn off antenna booster
- Retract and secure awnings and check awning locks
- Close slide outs and secure
- Close and lock windows
- Close roof vents
- Close and lock exhaust vent openings (stove vent)
- Close and secure window awnings
- Turn off hot water heater (gas and electric)
- Turn off roof A/C (unless you plan to use it on the trip)
- Turn off furnace (unless you plan to use it)
- Close propane supply valve (unless used)
- Secure all loose items inside the RV and cabinets
- Stow sink covers
- Check all door and cabinet locks
- Drain holding tanks (if connected to sewer)
- Add water to holding tanks (clean during trip)
- Turn off water pump
- Disconnect and store sewer drain hose and adapters
- Disconnect and store water hose, pressure regulator and fittings
- Disconnect and store power cord and adapters
- Retract stabilizers and store stabilizer pads
- Remove wheel chocks
- Conduct walk-around check to make sure the unit is secure
- Check site for water, electric and sewer adapters or anything missed
- Check around RV for safe exit of the site
- Retract entry step
